

About the usage of “Jabu-Jabu Ike (Pond)”

“Jabu-Jabu Ike” is the play pool for the infants before the elementary school age and who do not use diapers at all. Please follow the instructions of the staff when you use it.

About usage

Please take the following procedures when you use “Jabu-Jabu Ike”.

- Please remove the shoes and sandals at the entrance.
- The staff will confirm that the child does not regularly use diapers.
- Guardians must wash the foot using the attached shower.
- Please rinse below the neck of child using the shower.
- Please do not look away from the child during usage.
- Enjoy but please beware of the heat stroke.
- Please drink water frequently. When you drink water, please get out of “Jabu-Jabu Ike” .
- When you leave “Jabu-Jabu Ike”, please use the shower to rinse your child.

Restriction of usage

Person who falls into the following categories cannot use “Jabu-Jabu Ike”.

- Infants who always use diapers.
- Child older than elementary school age.
- Infants who do not wear the swim suit. (Use of diapers and pants for playing in the water are prohibited.)
- Infants who are not with guardians older than high school age.
- Infants and guardians who have infectious disease such as skin disease (water warts, impetigo etc.) and the hand-foot-and-mouth disease.
- Guardians who are drinking alcohol.
- Infants and guardians who may develop the annoying behavior.

Prohibited matter

The following activities are prohibited in “Jabu-Jabu Ike” .

- Eating and drinking other than drinking water.
- Use of breakable toys and a swimming float when crowded.
- Running in and around “Jabu-Jabu Ike”.
- Jumping into “Jabu-Jabu Ike”.
- No smoking. (Smoking is prohibited on a premise of park.)
- Other dangerous activities and the activities annoy the other users.
